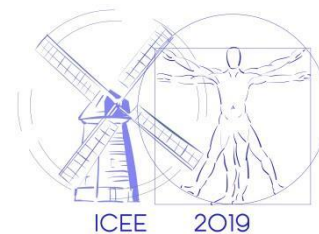

Submissions

The program committee reviewed the submissions and based on their recommendations the organization committee selected 67 submissions for oral presentation and 140 for oral presentation. 35 Submissions are related to the symposia; these were not reviewed by the program committee but communicated with the symposia coordinator. All authors have been informed about the decision and most of the submissions received specific recommendations for the abstract.

Revised abstracts can be re-submitted using the easychair website. Log into the system and attach the updated pdf file. Please submit your revised abstract **at latest on May 16**. We will print the abstract in the conference proceedings.

The daily program is shown below. We are currently planning the orals and posters in the dedicated sessions. You will be informed ASAP at which time slot your presentation is scheduled.

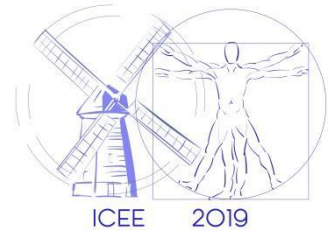

Poster presentations

There are about 140 poster presentations in total, divided over four days: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

The poster boards look like below. Each side will have a poster. The posters will be in the Marble hall. The posters can be discussed during the coffee and lunch breaks. Also, 30 minutes is allocated every day exclusively for discussion of the poster presentations. During this period all presenters should stand next to their posters.





The size of the poster stand is 195 cm x 125 cm so that only tall Dutch people can look over it ;). The size of the cardboard to attach the poster to is 148 cm x 125 cm. We therefore recommend that the poster is A0 portrait format.

The posters can be attached to the poster boards from 8:30 to 9:00 AM each day. They should be removed prior to 17:00 hours.

TIP: Add a photo of the presenter to the poster so that the audience knows who is the author.

Oral presentations

Presenters should contact the session chairs in the break prior to the presentation block. The chairs will be appointed in June. In most sessions there will be a junior and senior chair.

The presentations can be uploaded in the room that is just behind the presentation stage. Generally, PowerPoint is used for presentations. Check your presentation prior to the presentation block, in particular when you have movies included.

Registration

600 Euro for seniors,

300 Euro for students,

200 Euro for a single day,

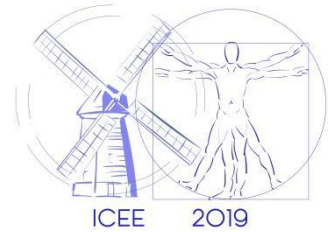
250 Euro for accompanying persons (includes coffee, lunches, conference dinner and boat tour).

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Accompanying persons only participating in the boat tour and dinner can pay 60 Euro cash at the dinner entrance (10 Euro for the boat tour and 50 Euro for the dinner). Please notify the organization if you want to use this option.

Student definition:

You must have completed your terminal degree (e.g., PhD, MD, etc) within a 5 year period prior to the abstract deadline or are currently registered as an undergraduate/graduate student. A document of eligibility will be needed, to be uploaded during registration. A copy of your student ID or a letter of recommendation, provided by your professor, or head of department.



The fee includes:

- Welcome reception
- Access to the conference and poster sessions
- Coffee, tea and special cookies (<https://koeckebackers.nl/>) prior to the daily conference start
- Coffee, tea and apple cake, chocolate truffle cake, white chocolate cake or lemon cheese cake during the morning breaks
- Lunch, with homemade soup, orange juice and other juices, biological milk, a mix of several sandwiches, wraps and bread pudding with meat, cheese, fish, crab salad, smoked salmon, Quinoa salad with grilled vegetables, salad of tomato and mozzarella, quiches of Pom Pie, spinach feta, curry, tai chicken and Guinness beef (we have to find out what this is) and different fruits (apple, banana, pears and mandarin)
- Drinks with Kummel-cheese cookies, nuts and vinegar and sea salt chips during the afternoon break
- Abstract book will be sent to you via email
- Conference dinner Thursday evening

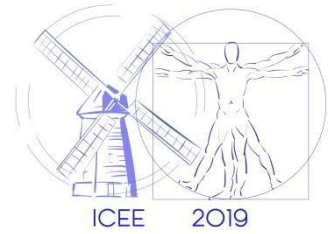
Payment:

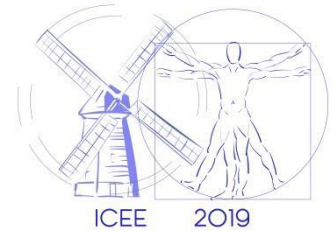


Hotel information
